## St Augustine's Church - vandalized leaded window

Dear Christine.

The cost to restore the damaged window & protect is  $\underline{\textbf{£980 + VAT}}$  fully inclusive of labour, materials and transport.

## Work includes

Removal of the full window (24" x 44") and securely board over At workshop partial restoration to the top half & fully re-lead the bottom half. Because the bottom half (24" x 24") is virtually destroyed, reference to be taken from a similar adjacent window.

All damaged glass and lead to be replaced on a like-for-like basis. Cement, clean glass & polish lead. Solder new 16gauge copper ties. Refit window to new saddle bars and point with lime mortar. We have allowed for protecting the window with 8mm polycarbonate u/v stabilized. We are only charging £100 + VAT because we are already on the job. As discussed there was a grill covering the window but during the break-in the vandals have disposed of it. It is right therefore that you include in your claim for the window to be re-protected. The cost to re-protect with s/s grill powder coated black would be £300 + VAT and there would be a delay having it fabricated. For this reason I propose 8mm polycarbonate instead of a grill because fitting polycarbonate can be carried out quickly and cheaply.
