Major churches represent some of the most special, significant and well-loved places of worship in England.

A major church has all or most of the following characteristics:

- Physically very big (over 1000m2 footprint)
- Grade I, II* or (exceptionally) II listed
- Exceptional significance and/or issues necessitating a conservation management plan
- Have a role or roles beyond those of a typical parish church and make a considerable civic, cultural and economic contribution to their communities

They are recognised as historically significant parish church buildings with a different scale of opportunities and challenges compared to the vast majority of other Church of England church buildings. Extending the pilot of the Cathedral Project Support Panel to the major churches is one way that the Church Buildings Council is seeking to improve the resources available to them. The Cathedral and Major Church Projects Support Panel, managed by the Association of English Cathedrals in partnership with the Major Churches Network, comprises a group of volunteer experts in a variety of fields who offer pro-bono advice at the pre-project stage to encourage the delivery of high quality, cost effective and timely buildings projects.

During this second pilot period, it is estimated that the Panel will be able to support 100 projects connected with major churches overall.
