Dear Sarah

Thank you for asking the parish to provide the detail requested on the method of re-adhesion for the marouflage panels at Christ Church, Erith. I have, with the parish's permission, also spoken with the conservator, Tom Organ, to ask some more detailed questions and I can confirm that the Council is satisfied with the approach to be taken regarding the panels. The proposed treatment is appropriately cautious, to stabilise where the canvas is lifting, without resorting to further unnecessary detachment. Any inaccessible areas of detachment will be treated by injection so that no further damage is caused.

The conservator has also assured me that he will communicate with the parish, once works are underway, if there is any change to the general approach, materials or methods taken in stabilising them. We are of course happy to remain involved, if that will be of help.
