A faculty dated 03/08/2020 authorised the following works subject to the following conditions:

The proposals is to move the organ from its previous position in the north transept to the back of the church on the south side of the west end of the nave. One of the objects of the current restoration project of the church is to provide a space for community activities within a village which has no village hall. This may well have been an influencing factor in the decision of various grant aiding bodies to fund the restoration. This work, which is now nearing completion, involved, among many other things, removing a collapsed suspended rotten wooden floor which formed a platform covering two thirds of the north transept. It has been replaced by tiles on the same level to match the rest of the floor. For this work the organ had to be removed and is currently stored, unassembled, in the middle of the chancel. Replacing in its original position would significantly reduce the usable space for activities that could otherwise be held in the north transept. It would also detract from the appearance of the east end of the church which has been considerably enhanced by the creation of this new tiled area. The proposed new location for the organ would not obstruct the use of the church. It would also allow the decorative organ case to be much more visible. It would bring the organ more into the body of the church. It might enhance its sound as it would no longer be wedged up against a wooden roof. It would also cover an unsightly very rough concrete floor.
