

CERTIFICATE OF PRACTICAL COMPLETION OF WORKS AUTHORISED BY FACULTY

In the Consistory Court of the Diocese of Lincoln

To the Registrar
Parish of Great Grimsby
Church of St Mary and St James

A FACULTY dated 19th March 2020 authorised the following works subject to the following conditions:

The carrying out of landscaping works primarily to the north of the church in the Parish churchyard, works to include the introduction of pathing, a labyrinth and three signage/noticeboards facing the square and to the west of the north entrance, the replacement of seating with two carved stone benches, the replacement of a bin, the replacement of seven external lighting columns and the introduction of a speaker system into three of the lighting columns, the replacement of four floodlights, the removal of six trees and the planting of seven trees, all to be in accordance with the Statement of Needs, ENGIE Design and Access Statement Project Number: TD003-18 dated March 2019, Arboricultural Report Version No 1 dated 27th April 2018, Drawings Numbers HD004-18/104 dated August 2019, HD004-18/106 dated September 2019, A003, A003 Revision C, A007 and A008 all dated 30th May 2019, A004 Revision C, A005 Revision A, A006 and 150 all dated July 2019, Scheme Ref HDxxx-xx Fisherman Memorial Foundation Standard Detail, and SIX 'Materials to be Used' Photographs, Urbis Schréder Limited Drawing Number OP000126021_01C Issue C dated 14th August 2019, CGC Ecology Bat Survey dated 2nd September 2019, Archaeological Project Services Heritage Statement Report No. HS/096 dated July 2019, and North East Lincolnshire Council Planning Permission letter Application Number DM/0827/19/FUL dated 19th November 2019, displayed at the parish church and lodged in the Diocesan Registry, and ENGIE E-mail dated 16th January 2020, lodged in the Diocesan Registry.

CONDITIONS

1. An amendment is to be made to Clause 4 of the Agreement made 24th November 1951 between (1) the Vicar of Grimsby St Mary and St James, (2) the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of Grimsby St Mary and St James and (3) The Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Grimsby made under and by virtue of the Open Spaces Act 1906 so that the uses of the land proposed by the Petitioners would be expressly included within Clause 4. Any incorporation by the Team Rector and Parochial Church Council to be permitted to enter such a Deed of Variation to incorporate such an amendment must be made to and approved by this Court before any works can commence. The form of the Deed of Variation once approved by the Court is to be appended hereto.
2. All excavations must be subject to an archaeological mitigation strategy.
3. If during the works any disarticulated human remains are uncovered and it is necessary to move them, they may be removed and reinterred as close to their original position as possible in consecrated land, all to be done under the supervision of a priest. If articulated human remains are uncovered, all works are to stop, and further directions obtained from this court.
4. The conditions of the North East Lincolnshire Council Planning Permission dated 19th November 2019 are conditions of this faculty.
5. The CGC Ecology Bat Survey dated 2nd September 2019 must be provided to the contractors who must work to it, in particular the requirements of paras 5.3-5.5.

ADDENDUM:

By Order of the Chancellor dated 23rd November 2020, this Faculty is hereby amended for the works to include the introduction of engraved artwork into 'Path 2', the combining of two benches into one 4m long bench on the west side of the east entrance, and the placement of a floodlight and a 2m long bench on the east side of the east entrance, all to be in accordance with the ENGIE e-mails dated 30th September, 8th, 12th and 23rd October 2020, Contemporary Public Arts Commissions Document and Path Annotations Document both dated 22nd September 2020, ONE Path Layout Plan, Path 2 Artwork Section 1 Document, Path 2 Artwork Section 2 Document, Path 2 Artwork Section 3 Document, INUS Addition Document and, Artwork Image for Scale Document, lodged in the Diocesan Registry.

By Order of the Chancellor dated 14th December 2020, this Faculty is hereby amended for the works to include the introduction of engraved artwork on to the 4m and 2m long benches situated on the west and east sides of the east entrance, all to be in accordance with the ENGIE e-mail dated 7th December 2020, THREE Seating Sides Artwork Documents and 3-D Mock-up of 4M Bench, lodged in the Diocesan Registry.

By Order of the Chancellor dated 14th December 2020, this Faculty is hereby amended to permit the reinterment of all disinterred human remains, and any further human remains that may be found, in the identified plots in the churchyard to the south west of Grimsby Minster, all to be in accordance with the Proposal for the Reinterment of Human Remains in the Churchyard of Grimsby Minster Document dated December 2020, PCAS Archaeology Plan of Inhumations identified as 2355 St James' Square Site Plan, and ENGIE Drawing No. 3000 dated September 2019 identified as Proposed Grave Locations, lodged in the Diocesan Registry.

1. All reinterments must take place by 13th January 2021
2. All reinterments must take place under the supervision of a priest.
