NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

To remove the existing free-standing chairs (approximate number 300). To introduce new free standing chairs (total number 350): (number) 200 Lightweight Skid Base Stacking Chair, 'T' nuts securing seat and back pads, upholstered with fire retardant foam and fabric, chrome frame, welded link, elasticated book pocket and fabric treated with stain protection. Colour: delta blue to tone with existing colours in church i.e. carpet (product code: SB2M). (number) 50 Armchair to match above. (product code: SBA). (number) 104 Polypropylene Folding Chair (in boxes of 8), blue seat and back. (product code: LF1DL) - for use only when additional seating is required.

The chairs used in the church originally were oak and likely to have come from the church hall (which was used for worship from 1913-1925). The set of beech chairs present currently was purchased during the 1940s to replace the oak chairs. Six of the original oak chairs remain within the church and will be retained, in addition to six of the beech chairs, if desired.

Directions to petitioner

You must display this public notice (or a copy of it) for a continuous period of not less than 28 days, not counting the day on which it was put up or the day on which it is taken down, (or for such other period as the Court may direct and subject to any special directions of the registrar) in each of the following places:

1. on a notice board or in some other prominent position inside the church; and
2. on a notice board outside the church or in some other prominent position (whether on the outside of the church door or elsewhere) so that it can be read by the public.
