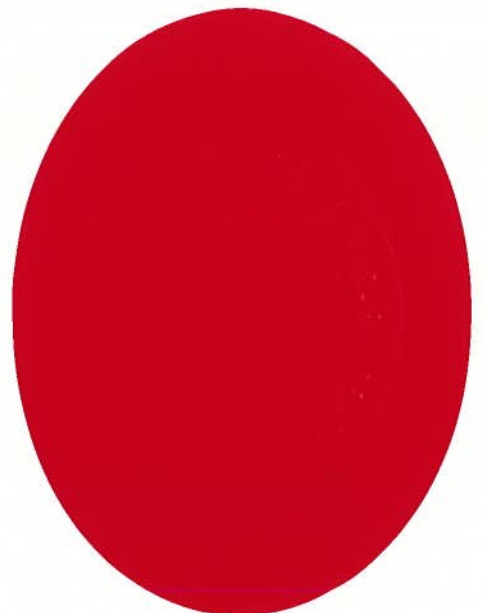

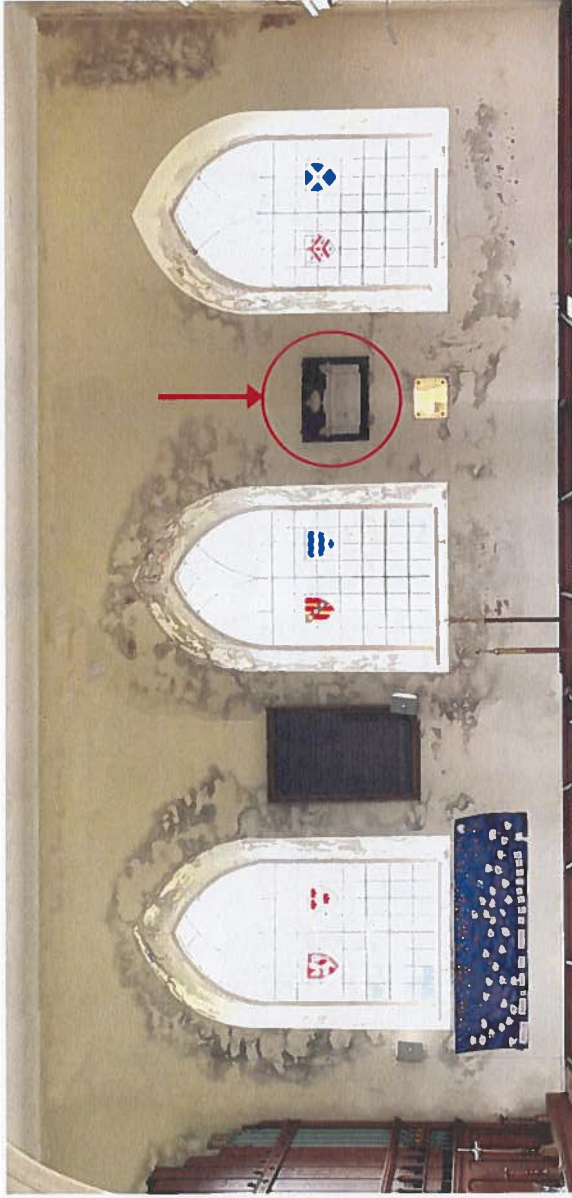

CONDITION AND PROPOSED WORK

Condition poor - heavily decayed ferrous cramps, only 1 still performing function. Backing slate looks to be broken in 3. 1 vertical crack to the right of centre, 1 horizontal crack running left to right, assumed runs into the vertical crack. Marble inscription panel pushed forward RH side, possible ferrous expansion behind as cause. Carefully dismantle, repair slabs as necessary and reinstate with stainless steel cramps and pins.

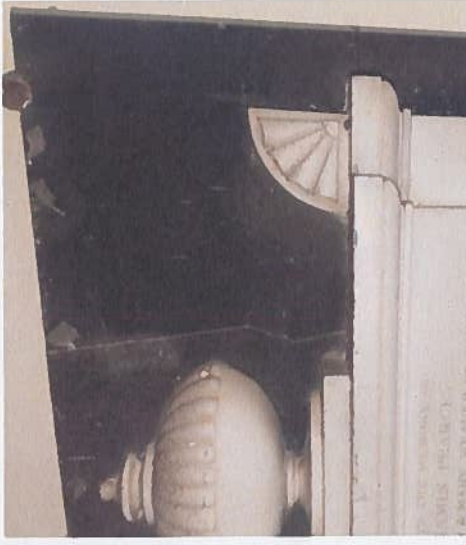

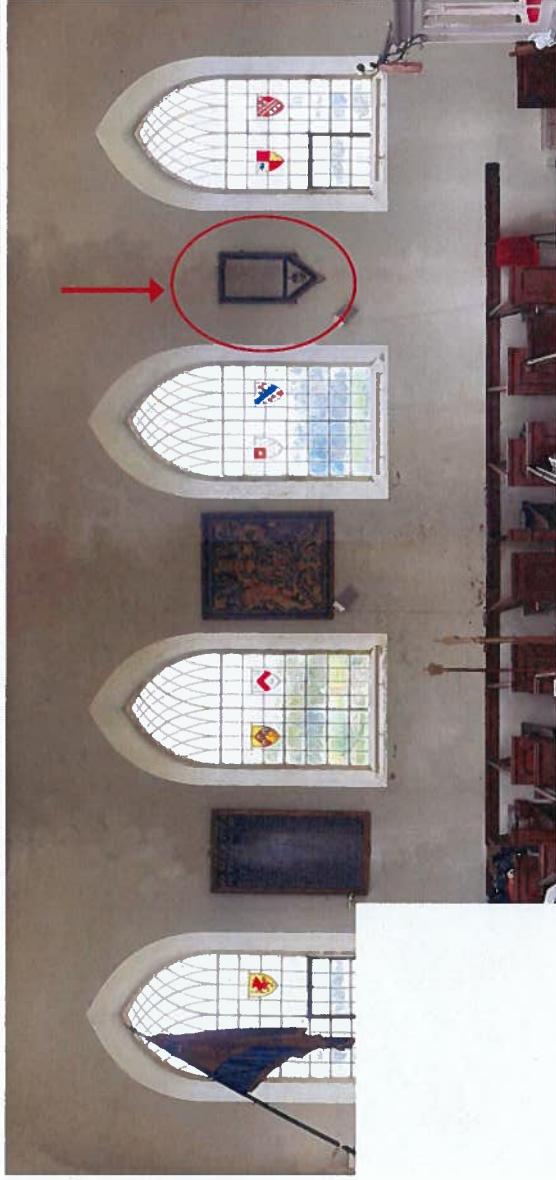

CONDITION AND PROPOSED WORK

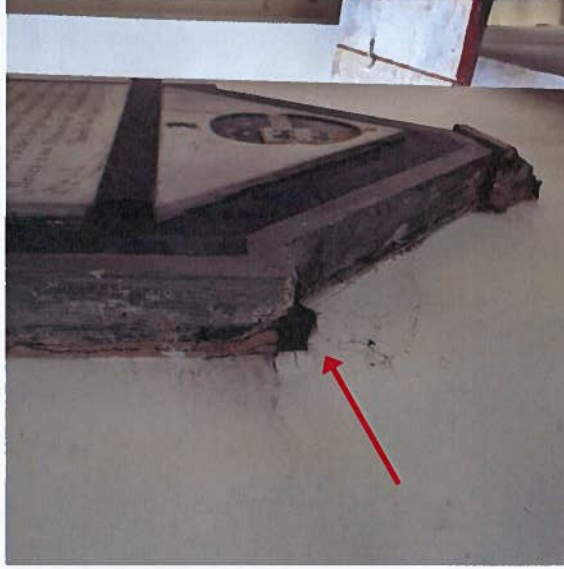
Decayed ferrous cramps to be replaced with stainless steel. memorial to be retained in situ, support beneath and remove/replace cramps one at a time.

No repair to stonework thought to be necessary but reassessed as work progresses. Likely to be very minimal.
