External and internal interpretation to be installed as part of the wider Project Newton that is the subject of the extant faculty application reference number 2018-018454. The proposed interpretation is set out in the attached drawings. In summary it includes the following - 2 interpretation boards and some additional seating in the churchyard - In the south porch a touchscreen and interactive educational game and 2 new notice boards and an interpretation panel - In the nave a touchscreen and interpretation panels next to the Karl Parsons stained glass window and at the south end of the rood screen - A new curtain in the chancel and new kneelers with the St Laurence church motif
