Works: To visit site, take rubbings, remove fragments, and temporarily seal the damaged area. Repair in studio and fit new repair piece using blackened traditional linseed oil putty. The repaired stained glass piece will be made using glass matching the existing in tint, colour, and texture. The Painted repair to be traditionally painted and kiln fired to match the existing in paint and stain colours and painting style. To secure up to 20 fractured pieces in situ across all three base panels with epoxy resin where possible, rake out and repoint the cill in lime mortar.
